what you have given my family."



Developer's CORNER

Union Park is now home to 215 families with more arriving every day! The builders have begun selling homes in the newest section of lots, located south of Fish Trap Road. The balance of these lots, north of Fish Trap Road, are under construction and projected to be completed in early 2018.

Landscape improvements to the open space between HWY 380 and Forest Street is underway and will be finished by Fall 2017. What a great place for families to get UP and get out to play!

The construction of Union Park Boulevard West is on schedule and is projected to be open to traffic in November. The opening of the road will provide an alternate route for vehicular traffic and will complete the infrastructure around the pond north of the Cove. It is anticipated that the pond will be stocked and open for fishing in January 2018. Get your fishing poles ready!
